Sadly, Brain tumours are a devastating cancer that kill more children and adults under the age of 40 than any other form of cancer, affecting up to 16,000 UK people each year. BTR receives just **1%** of all Cancer researches national spend, hence fundraising is a priority focus of the BTR charity!

The BTR Charity oversees fund raising activities and events throughout the year, including the annual **BTR Randonnee**, a non-competitive cycle ride around the entire perimeter of the Isle of Wight. The organizer of this particular event is the vice-chairman Simon Tier of our local Fareham Wheelers cycling club's organized this year's event on the 18th July. 92 riders undertaking, a 45 mile or 70 mile I.O.W. circuit. Three feeding stations were setup en-route to provide much needed refreshments. Locks Heath Rotary donations helped cover the refreshment costs.
